Public Policy Program It is designed to cover the public policy process, from identifying issues to formulating, implementing, and evaluating policies. Underlying this design is the growing importance of related knowledge and expertise to the policy process, including expertise in political science, public administration studies, and business management-style efficiency.</p> <p>2. International Development Policy Program Drawing on disciplines concerned with international economics and the environment, the program is designed to give JDS Fellows an understanding of the global issues of sustainable development and poverty as viewed from various social system perspectives. While economic development based on market principles has created a wealthy society, it has also posed global problems such as environmental degradation and income disparity.</p> <p>3. Community Planning and Management Program The community is where governance comes most closely in contact with people's lives. Framing global issues from local perspectives, the program is organized around the process of making, implementing, and evaluating policies for the solution. It also focuses on crisis management and the role of the community in responding to natural disasters and terrorism, which have been increasing in recent years.</p>

Strengthening of analysis, evaluation and planning in public policy</p>	<p>The program has two key features: firstly it focuses on comparative research into politics and administration in Asia for a Master’s degree, secondly, instruction and program administration are managed entirely in English.</p> <p>The successful achievement of nation building in Asia is now being challenged at three levels: local, national, and global. What once were questions of problems of maintaining political organization and administrative organization are now often covered under governance theory. There were many cases where government theory was equated only with the formal political system, but greater attention is now being paid in the analysis of Asian politics to how a country is actually ruled and how policies are formulated in practice. These themes treat the global, national and local levels not as separate layers but as interacting components. In recognition of this changing context of contemporary Asia, the program has been launched at Kyushu University’s Faculty of Law.</p>
