Background
<p>In Sri Lanka, since policies are changed each time the administration is altered, issues have emerged on dispersion of administrative organizations, duplication of functions and services, inefficiency of administrative procedures, etc. In 2007, the National Administrative Reform Council (NARC) was established for the purpose of administrative reform, and action plans for such purpose have been developed. (NARC later came under the purview of Ministry of Public Management Reforms in 2010). However, it is still necessary to develop human resources who can contribute to system/policy planning from the medium-to-long-term viewpoint based on those action plans.</p> <p>It is expected that the JDS project will improve and facilitate the administrative capacity of Sri Lanka from the long-term viewpoint and to improve the capacity of human resources concerning institutional organization.</p>
